## MGB

Readers of *Safety Fast!* and other British sports car magazines frequently see pictures of the MGB works cars in Tartan Red with Old English White hard top, and of course most of the cars with the famous history are still here in the UK.

However, in Denmark they have their very own MGB 'works car' which is the oldest MGB in Denmark as it was the first to be imported in September 1962 and it has a long and famous racing history.

The car has participated in racing from the early sixties throughout the whole of Scandinavia, starting with the Roskilde Ring in 1963 where the English driver Jenny Tudor-Owen in MGB registration 665 FXF was a participant in a race there. She introduced the new MGB to the racing spectators and drivers as a relatively cheap sports car to race.

The car is now in mint condition and looks like the original works cars. Sixty-four-year-old Dane John Milland has been the current owner for over 10 years. He is an old Mini Cooper racer, but now takes part in historic FIA circuit racing with his lovely MGB in the 65 GT class.

The car, driven by John, has participated in most of the Copenhagen Historic Grand Prix, which take place in the middle of the capital of Denmark, near to the Houses of Parliament.
